- •Glass Jars & Bottles (all colors)
  - (remove lids)
- #1- #7 Plastic Bottles & Containers (no lids)
- cereal & food boxes, etc. Aluminum & Bimetal Cans
  - Steel & Tin Cans
  - Aluminum Foil & Formed **Containers**
  - Paper Gift Wrap
  - Phone & Paperback Books
  - Juice, Soup & Drink Boxes (aseptic packaging)
  - Paper Milk & Juice Cartons (gable top)

#### Remember to...

Face your bin with the handle towards the house in an unobstructed location



# These items are NOT accepted at curbside collection

Chip bags \* Snack wrappers \* Styrofoam (meat trays, etc.) \* Compostable plastics \* Plastic utensils & straws \* Durable plastic goods (chairs, toys, totes, etc.) \* Photographs \* Carry-out coffee cups \* Paper towels \* Tissues Paper plates \* Waxed paper \* Waxed cardboard (frozen/refrigerated food or drink boxes) \* Ice-cream boxes \* Soda/beer boxes \* Pizza boxes \* Scrap metal \* Hardcover books
