

- Wrap tubes in newspaper; secure with tape
- ▶ Place bulbs in a sealed clear plastic bag
- ▶ Limit 2 tubes/bulbs per collection
- Max 4' long



Household Batteries

- > Separate and bag batteries by type
- ▶ Tape ends of ALL batteries
- ▶ Visit recology.com/bothell for battery preparation instructions

Cooking Oil and Kitchen Grease

- ▶ Put in clear, screw-top plastic jugs
- ▶ Label jugs with name and address
- ▶ Limit: 3 gallons per collection

Small Appliances & Electronics

- > 2' x 2' x 2' or smaller and less than 60 lbs
- ▶ Place electronics in a clear plastic bag
- Limit: 4 items per collection

ACCEPTED ITEMS

- VCRs, TVs, DVD players
- ▶ Cell phones, MP3 players
- ▶ Computers, keyboards, printers
- Stereos, microwaves

Motor Oil

- ▶ Put in clear, screw-top plastic jugs
- Label jugs with name and address
- ▶ Limit: 3 gallons per collection

Textiles

Place clean, dry clothing and household textiles in a clear plastic bag



Small Propane Canisters

- ▶ Place in a box
- ▶ Empty canisters only
- ▶ NO propane tanks

Scrap Metal

- Examples: pipes, fencing, aluminum chair frames bike parts
- 6' or smaller and less than 65 lbs



Styrofoam[™] Blocks*

- ▶ Remove tape or labels
- ▶ Place Styrofoam™ in a clear plastic bag
- No packing peanuts


