



Kitchen Tips

Collect food scraps and food-soiled paper in a washable, lidded container.

To keep your container clean:

- Line with used paper towels, newspaper, shredded paper, or compostable bags.
- Sprinkle food scraps with baking soda to limit odors.
- Freeze or refrigerate food scraps in container or compostable bag until collection day.



No hazardous waste or prohibited items

Extra Garbage

- There is a charge for garbage that does not fit in your garbage cart with the lid closed.
- Put additional garbage in 32-gallon (or smaller) cans or bags.
