SMALL BUSINESS HAZARDOUS WASTE

Does your business generate hazardous waste? Do you have products that are corrosive, reactive, toxic or ignitable? You may generate hazardous waste.

Small businesses with hazardous waste may be eligible to participate in the County's small business hazardous waste program (fees apply):

Step 1: Have your EPA ID # ready. If you don't have one, visit DTSC.ca.gov/ and use the navigation menu to find the information you're looking for.

Step 2: Call **800.207.8222** to make a hazardous waste appointment. Appointments are available every Friday from 9am-2pm at the Yolo County Central Landfill.

STATE LAW AB 341: MANDATORY COMMERCIAL RECYCLING

Requires all businesses that generate 4 or more cubic yards of waste each week and all multi-family communities with 5 or more units to have recycling service for cardboard, paper, plastics, glass and cans.

Arrange to collect and donate, sell and/or self-haul recyclables to recycling facilities as allowed under Yolo County Ordinance No. 1378. To learn more, visit: calrecycle.ca.gov/recycle/commercial

- Plastic containers

STATE LAW AB 1826: MANDATORY COMMERCIAL ORGANICS

Businesses that generate 2 cubic yards or more of commercial garbage per week shall arrange for organic waste recycling services. Organic waste includes food waste, green waste, landscape and pruning waste, nonhazardous wood waste, and food-soiled paper waste that is mixed in with food waste. - Rice, beans & pasta
- Eggshells
- Dairy products (no liquids)
- Plants & yard waste
- Coffee grounds & filters
- Tea bags
- Bio-bags
- Paper napkins, towels, cups & plates
- Uncoated paper take-out containers
- Waxed cardboard and milk cartons
- Greasy pizza boxes

✗ ITEMS UNACCEPTED

- Juice, soup & other shelf-stable cartons
- Plastics
- Glass
- Metals
- Dirt, rock & concrete
- Cat litter & pet waste
- Non-compostable material

Landfill

CALIFORNIA LAW

Prohibits the disposal of hazardous waste in landfills. These materials may contain mercury, lead, and other substances that are hazardous to human health and the environment.
