

## Accepted Items

ALL Materials must be within the following limits to be collected

### Reusable Items

**No household garbage**

**MAX of 2 cubic yards** (equal to twelve 32g plastic clear bags or boxes) of reusable or gently used materials



### Bulky Items

**MAX of 2 items**

Large items like washers, dryers, and freezers; refrigerators count as 2 items due to the Freon



### E-Waste Items

**MAX of 5 items**

printer, TV, phone, computers and their components



Recology provides these **FREE** services up to **2 times a year!**

## Multi-Family Dwellings

Property manager/owner must call Recology to schedule the 2 FREE bulky item collections a year

## WARNING!

**FOR THE SAFETY OF OUR EMPLOYEES:**

We CANNOT accept liquids, sludge, dirt, rock, hot ashes, concrete, asphalt, hazardous, infectious waste, abandoned cars, trees, garbage, or any single item that **cannot** be managed by one **person**



## NO Hazardous Waste

Hazardous Waste such as old paint, pesticides, compact fluorescent lights and cleaning products, if not disposed of properly, can contaminate our soil, drinking water and are illegal to throw in the garbage

## Beyond the Cart

### Used Oil and Oil Filters:

Call 831.636.7500 for up to three one-gallon plastic jugs for your used motor oil and one zippered plastic bag for used oil filters. Leave the filled jugs and bag on the curb next to your Blue Recyclables Cart on the day of your service and we'll pick them up

You can recycle your old household batteries, used motor oil, and filters curbside
