Secure On-Site Paper Shredding

- Recology will accept boxes of paper to be shred securely on site
- Shredding truck has a magnet to collect staples and paper clips attached to paper

Electronic Waste Recycling

- Bring unwanted laptops, TV's, cellphones, stereo equipment, small microwaves, batteries, game consoles, printers, computers and their components
- Designated E-Waste staff will safely remove materials straight from your car!

Compost Giveaway

- Please bring a **Bucket, Shovel & Container** to collect compost with
- Each resident may receive up to 32 gallons of compost (first come first served basis so come **EARLY!**)
- Tarp must be used to cover truck bed loads of compost to prevent spilling

Community Food Bank is helping to reduce waste in San Benito County through this reuse store and participating in Recology's recycling and organics waste reduction programs.

FREE Bulky Item On-Call Curbside Collection Program

Recology will provide residential customers with FREE Bulky Item Curbside collection up to two (2) times per year, upon request.

This Program includes:

- MAX of two (2) cubic yards (equal to twelve (12), 32-gallon plastic clear bags or boxes) of reusable or gently used materials
- MAX of two (2) Bulky Items (appliances with Freon count as two (2) Bulky Items)
- MAX of five (5) Electronic Waste or Universal Waste Items

Prohibited Items include:

hazardous materials, abandoned cars, trees, household garbage, or any single item that cannot be managed by one person.

We will take great care to ensure that items we pick up can be recycled or donated in an ecologically and socially responsible manner.
