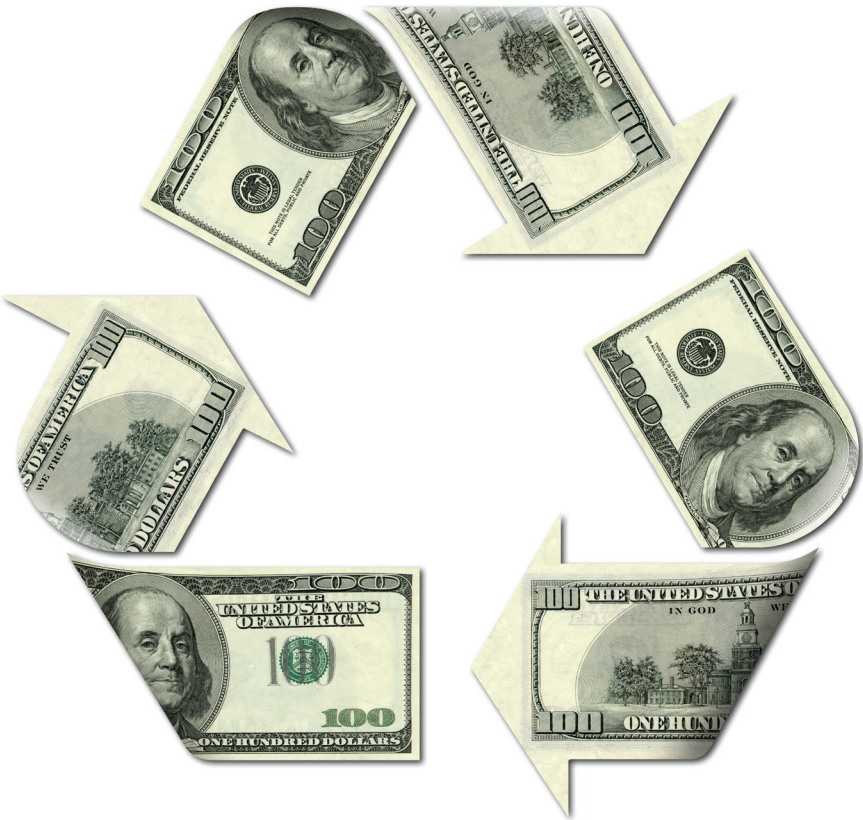

Recycle

Recycling service is provided at no additional charge. By recycling more and reducing your garbage, it's possible to lower your garbage service level – resulting in cost savings.

California State Law (AB) 341 requires commercial properties that generate four(4) or more cubic yards of solid waste per week to enroll in recycling service.

Compost

Depending on your location, compost service is discounted or provided at no additional charge. By composting more and reducing your garbage, it's possible to lower your garbage service level – resulting in cost savings.

California State Law (AB) 1826 requires commercial properties that generate four(4) or more cubic yards of solid waste per week to enroll in compost service.

Garbage
