WHAT GOES IN THE RECYCLE BIN?

Please do not place recyclable materials in plastic bags, as the recycling facility is unable to process those materials. Paper bags are acceptable.

Accepted Recycling Materials

Glass (no liquids or food)



✓ Glass bottles and jars only (metal caps & lids too)

Metal (no liquids or food)



- ✓ Aluminum cans, foil & trays (ball foil up to softball size)
- ✓ Caps & lids from bottles, jars & steel (tin) cans
- ✓ Paint cans (empty or dry)
- ✓ Spray cans (must be empty)
- ✓ Steel (tin) cans

Plastic bottles, tubs, & jugs (rinsed)



- ✓ Bottles (leave caps on)
- ✓ Containers & clam shells
- ✓ Laundry detergent bottles
- ✓ Tubs & lids (yogurt containers & Tupperware)

Paper (clean, dry & unsoiled)



- ✓ Bags (paper only; no plastic or "compostable" plastic)
- ✓ Cardboard (non-waxed)
- √ Cereal boxes
- √ Office paper
- √ Egg cartons
- ✓ Envelopes (windows okay)
- Juice or soy milk type boxes with foil liner
- ✓ Junk mail & magazines
- ✓ Newspapers
- √ Packing paper
- √ Phonebooks
- ✓ Sticky notes ("Post-its")
- Waxy paper milk or juice cartons
- ✓ Wrapping paper (non-metallic)

Unaccepted Recyclables







- Hazardous Waste (batteries, fluorescent lamps, HID light bulbs, e-waste & appliances, paint, chemicals, motor oil, cooking oil & grease, etc.)
- Plastic labeled "Compostable" or "Biodegradable" (utensils, cups, lined paper, etc.)
- Organics (food scraps, yard trimmings, wood, etc.)
- Ceramic dishware or glassware
- Clothing, linens & rags
- Coat hangers
- Electronics
- Foil-backed or plastic-backed paper
- Glass mirrors & windows
- Plastic bags, wrappers or film
- Plastic items mixed w/metal, fabric or rubber
- Scrap metal
- Shredded paper
- Soiled paper
- Styrofoam
- Waxed cardboard & paper
- Liquids or ice
