Our Single-Stream Recycling Program allows multi-family dwellings to combine bottles, cans, mixed paper, newspaper and cardboard together in your current recycling cart or bin.
Below is a list of materials that are accepted in the Single-Stream Recycling Program:

food containers, and meat packing trays)
Syringes and other medical waste

Plastics, with or without symbols \#1-\#7
Shrink wrap

Wrapping paper


## CARDBOARD

Please break down and cut to fit inside of cart or bin. Extra cardboard that cannot fit inside cart should be flattened into 3' x 3' sections and placed alongside the recycling cart.
PLEASE REMOVE ALL PACKING MATERIALS before placing cardboard boxes in your recycling cart.
Please rinse food and beverage containers before placing in cart.

## Recycling IT'S THE LAW!

The new California Assembly Bill (AB) 341 requires all businesses that generate five (5) or more cubic yards of garbage per week and multi-family dwellings with five (5) or more units to recycle by July 1, 2012.

## Effective July 1, 2012

Multi-family dwellings include apartments, townhomes and condominiums.

The purpose of the new law is to:

- Reduce garbage from landfills
- Reduce greenhouse gas emissions
