

Our Single-Stream Recycling Program allows multi-family dwellings to combine bottles, cans, mixed paper, newspaper and cardboard together in your current recycling cart or bin.

Below is a list of materials that are accepted in the Single-Stream Recycling Program:



UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS:

Auto parts Ceramics **Clothes hangers** Food contaminated paper products and packaging Fuel tanks Garden hoses Hazardous waste Household batteries Light bulbs Pizza boxes PVC or other plastic piping Rope Styrofoam/Polystyrene (packing "peanuts", packaging block, carryout food containers, and meat packing trays) Syringes and other medical waste Waxed cardboard Window glass Wire

ACCEPTABLE MATERIALS

Adhesive notes Aluminum, tin & bi-metal cans Aluminum foil & pie pans (clean) Brown paper grocery bags Cardboard (cut to fit inside toter) Catalogs Cereal boxes (remove liners) Colored paper Computer paper Construction paper Cracker boxes (remove liners) Discharged metal spray cans Envelopes (with windows ok) Gift boxes Glass bottles & jars Junk mail Magazines Metal lids from glass bottles & jars Metal pots & pans Milk carton & juice box "aseptics" **Newspapers & inserts** Paper egg cartons Paper towel rolls Phone books Plastics, with or without symbols #1 - #7 Shrink wrap White paper Wrapping paper

CARDBOARD

Please break down and cut to fit inside of cart or bin. Extra cardboard that cannot fit inside cart should be flattened into 3' x 3' sections and placed alongside the recycling cart.

PLEASE REMOVE ALL PACKING MATERIALS before placing cardboard boxes in your recycling cart.

Please rinse food and beverage containers before placing in cart.

Recycling IT'S THE LAW!

Assembly Bill 341 Mandatory Commercial Recycling

The new California Assembly Bill (AB) 341 requires all businesses that generate five (5) or more cubic yards of garbage per week and multi-family dwellings with five (5) or more units to recycle by July 1, 2012.

Effective July 1, 2012

Multi-family dwellings include apartments, townhomes and condominiums.

The purpose of the new law is to:

- Reduce garbage from landfills
- Reduce greenhouse gas emissions
