PLEASE RINSE OUT ALL RECYCLE ITEMS

Plastic Tub, Jugs,
Jars, and Bottles
#1, 2, 4, 5, 7

Glass bottles and jars
(lids off)



Tin, aluminum,
pie tins, and foil
(clean and in a ball)

Newspaper
Cereal Boxes
Paper (bagged)
Paper Egg Cartons
Cardboard, Paperboard
Shredded paper (bagged)
Opened junk mail (bagged)



By recycling one ton of paper we save:

- 17 trees
- 6,953 gallons of water
- 463 gallons of oil
- 587 pounds of air pollution
- 3.06 cubic yards of landfill space

For every ton of glass recycled, we save over a ton of resources:

- 1,330 pounds of sand
- 433 pounds of soda ash
- 433 pounds of limestone
- 151 pounds of feldspar
