It's always a great time to clean out your closets and other cluttered areas of your home. When looking at items that you don't want anymore, like clothing, remember to donate or give to a friend-Reuse! (gently used please)

For your unwanted clothes and other household items that are in good and working condition, here are four Morgan Hill organizations that will accept your donations:

Goodwill of Silicon Valley

Goodwill store located 17630 Monterey Road (408) 778-3253 Donations accepted Monday through Sunday, 9am-8pm. Items accepted: Clothing, shoes, furniture, household items, electronics, toys, etc. They do not accept appliances (eg: refrigerators and stoves). Call the store if you have specific questions. Store open for purchases Monday through Sunday, 9am-8pm.

Goodwill trailer located at 840 East Dunne Ave. (near Safeway) Trailer open for donations and purchases Monday through Sunday 8am-4:30pm.

Learning and Loving Education Center

16890 Church St. #16 (408) 776-1196 Donations accepted Wednesday through Friday, 8am-2pm. Items accepted: Clothing and shoes for all ages, bedding, towels, kitchen items, small kitchen appliances, toys, and baby items. Donations of large items must be by appointment only.

Recycle your Batteries!

Many batteries are purchased during the holiday season. Buy rechargeable batteries to accompany your electronic gifts, and consider giving a battery charger as well. Rechargeable batteries reduce the amount of potentially harmful materials thrown away, and can save money in the long run.

You can recycle your batteries at home. You can put regular household batteries (AAA-D, 9V, button cell, rechargeable) in a clear, zippered bag and set them on top of your brown recycling cart. Batteries cannot be thrown away.

Recycling Electronic Waste

Electronic waste, also known as E-waste, is harmful to the environment when improperly disposed of. If your unwanted E-waste is still in good working condition, donate it! Call the **Santa Clara County Household Hazardous Waste Hotline** at **(408) 299-7300** or go to **HHW.org** to find local places that need your unwanted items for reuse or recycling.

When you go to HHW.org, click on *"Approved Electronic Waste Collector"* on the right side of the page.

You may also recycle these items at a Santa Clara County Household Hazardous Waste event.

Please schedule an appointment before dropping off your items.

CHRISTMAS TREE RECYCLING

Before setting your tree out on your curb for recycling pick-up:

- Cut trees into three-feet by three-feet sections
- Remove all decorations and tinsel
- Remove tree stand (especially if it is drilled inside the trunk)
- Flocked trees are acceptable
