Reduce Your Waste During the Holidays!

Here are some ideas that can help reduce the amount of garbage created and maybe even reduce the amount of money you spend this season:

- Homemade gifts, such as baked treats, are always appreciated
- Give a donation in someone's name
- Give a "coupon" for helpful tasks: walking the dog, cooking meals, housework, etc.

For the waste you do create, remember to recycle!

- Tissue wrapping paper is acceptable
- Foil wrapping paper is NOT recyclable
- Ribbons and bows are not recyclable, but they are reusable



Christmas Tree Recycling

There are two ways residents can recycle Christmas trees at the curb:

Local Boy Scout Troops 436 and 428 will be collecting and recycling Christmas trees again in the Cities of Hollister, San Juan Bautista, and the surrounding neighborhoods on the following dates:

- Saturday, January 2nd
- Sunday, January 3rd
- Saturday, January 9th

Trees need to be at the curb by 9am on those dates. Boy Scouts do not require trees to be cut. A donation of \$8 is appreciated and supports local Boy Scout activities and the Gerry Rawn Endowment Fund. For more information, call (831) 637-8022.

Recology San Benito County can also pick up your Christmas tree for recycling on your garbage and recycling collection days between January 4th and January 22nd.

Before setting your tree at the curb for recycling by Recology you need to do the following:

- CUT TREES into three-feet by three-feet sections
- Remove all decorations, tinsel and stands
- Flocked trees are acceptable

Remember the Three "Rs" During the Holidays

Reduce	Make the gift wrap part of the gift. For example: wrap kitchen items inside a pretty kitchen towel.
Reuse	Reuse gift bags, wrap and bows you have been saving from gifts you have received.
Recycle	Recycle your wrapping paper! (bows are reusable, not recyclable)

Used Motor Oil & Filter Recycling: So Many Options!

Did you know that used motor oil never wears out? It just gets dirty and can be recycled, cleaned, and used again. Recycling used motor oil conserves a natural resource (oil) and is good for the environment, too! Motor oil poured onto the ground or into storm drains, or tossed into trash cans (even in a sealed container) can contaminate and pollute the soil, groundwater, streams, and rivers. Recycling your used motor oil reduces this pollution threat.

In San Benito County you have options when it comes to recycling your used motor oil and filters.



One option is Recology San Benito County. Recology will accept up to 3 gallons of used oil and 3 used oil filters per week placed properly at curbside (residential customers only). Call customer service at (831) 636-7500 to request oil containers and oil filter bags and place them next to your recycle cart on service day.

Another option is dropping them off at one of the following locations. The following locations accept used motor oil at no charge and many of them accept used oil filters.

Please do not drop off your oil or oil filters if the business is closed.

Bulky Item Drop-Off Events

There are four opportunities each year for residents (not businesses) to drop off specific items at the John Smith Road Landfill for FREE.

The last 2015 dates are December 26th & 27th, 9am to 3pm

The **2016** drop-off event dates are Saturdays and Sundays, 9am to 3pm, on these dates:

- March 26 & 27
- June 25 & 26
- September 24 & 25
- December 17 & 18
