### There are two ways residents can recycle Christmas trees at the curb:

Local Boy Scout Troops 436 and 428 will be collecting and recycling Christmas trees again in Hollister, San Juan Bautista, and surrounding neighborhoods on the following dates:

- Sunday, January 8

## Holiday Collection Schedule

Christmas and New Year's both fall on Sunday and there will be no service interruption on Monday, December 26, 2016 or Monday, January 2, 2017.

Recology San Benito County will pick up your Christmas tree for recycling on your garbage and recycling collection days between January 2nd and January 20th.

Before setting your tree out curbside for recycling pick up, you must do the following:

• Cut trees into three-feet by three-feet sections

 Remove all decorations, tinsel and stands
