Household Batteries

- Place button and alkaline batteries in sealed clear plastic bag
- Place rechargeable and non-rechargeable batteries in separate bags

Motor Oil

- ▶ Put in clear, screw-top plastic jugs
- Label jugs with name and address
- Limit: 3 gallons per collection

Textiles

Place clean, dry clothing and household textiles in a clear plastic bag



Put in clear, screw-top plastic jugs


