- Max 4' long



Household Batteries

- ▶ Place button and alkaline batteries in sealed clear plastic bag
- ▶ Place rechargeable and non-rechargeable batteries in separate bags

Motor Oil

- ▶ Put in clear, screw-top plastic jugs
- ▶ Label jugs with name and address
- ▶ Limit: 3 gallons per collection

Textiles

▶ Place clean, dry clothing and household textiles in a clear plastic bag




Cooking Oil and Kitchen Grease

Put in clear, screw-top plastic jugs

- Label jugs with name and address
- ▶ Limit: 3 gallons per collection

Small Appliances & Electronics

- 2' x 2' x 2' or smaller and less than 60 lbs
- Place electronics in a clear plastic bag
- Limit: 4 items per collection



- VCRs, TVs, DVD players
- ▶ Cell phones, MP3 players
- ▶ Computers, keyboards, printers
- Stereos, microwaves

Small Propane Canisters

- ▶ Place in a box
- ▶ Empty canisters only
- ▶ NO propane tanks

Scrap Metal

- 6' or smaller and less than 65 lbs



Styrofoam[™] Blocks*

- ▶ Remove tape or labels
- ▶ Place Styrofoam™ in a clear plastic bag
- ▶ No packing peanuts







