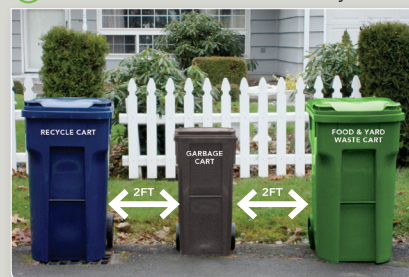

Cart Placement

Please place containers at curb by 7am

NO HOLIDAY COLLECTION:
If your collection day falls on or after Thanksgiving or Christmas Day, your collection will be one day later that week.



COLLECTION ISSUES:
Call customer service within 24 hours to report missed collections. Visit our website for collection updates and weather delays.

CART PLACEMENT:
Where possible, place carts:
▶ Two feet apart with lids opening toward the street
▶ Without blocking cars, mailboxes, sidewalks, or driveways
▶ Within five feet of the street
▶ Remove carts from street as soon as possible after collection.

YOUR COLLECTION DAY IS

FREE! Special Item Recycling

Picked up at the curb — place on top of or next to recycle cart.

Fluorescent Tubes & Bulbs

- ▶ Fluorescent lights are a household hazardous waste
- ▶ Wrap tubes in newspaper; secure with tape
- ▶ Place bulbs in a sealed clear plastic bag
- ▶ Limit 2 tubes/bulbs per collection
- ▶ Max 4' long



Household Batteries

- ▶ Place button and alkaline batteries in sealed clear plastic bag
- ▶ Place rechargeable and non-rechargeable batteries in separate bags



Motor Oil

- ▶ Put in clear, screw-top plastic jugs
- ▶ Label jugs with name and address
- ▶ Limit: 3 gallons per collection



Textiles

- ▶ Place clean, dry clothing and household textiles in a clear plastic bag



Cooking Oil and Kitchen Grease

- Put in clear, screw-top plastic jugs
- ▶ Label jugs with name and address
- ▶ Limit: 3 gallons per collection



Small Appliances & Electronics

- ▶ 2' x 2' x 2' or smaller and less than 60 lbs
- ▶ Place electronics in a clear plastic bag
- ▶ Limit: 4 items per collection



ACCEPTED ITEMS

- ▶ VCRs, TVs, DVD players
- ▶ Cell phones, MP3 players
- ▶ Computers, keyboards, printers
- ▶ Stereos, microwaves

Small Propane Canisters

- ▶ Place in a box
- ▶ Empty canisters only
- ▶ NO propane tanks



Scrap Metal

- ▶ Examples: pipes, fencing, aluminum chair frames, bike parts
- ▶ 6' or smaller and less than 65 lbs



Styrofoam™ Blocks*

- ▶ Remove tape or labels
- ▶ Place Styrofoam™ in a clear plastic bag
- ▶ No packing peanuts

*Styrofoam™ requires a special scheduled collection. Please submit a Service Request Form at recologycleanscapes.com/bothell, or call customer service to request collection.

Empty and Clean Recyclables Only

- Place items loose in the recycling cart, not in bags or cartons.
- Place additional recyclables in clearly labeled sturdy bins or boxes next to the recycling cart.

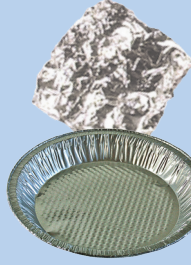

Extra Yard Debris — charges apply

Put extra yard debris in:

- Heavy paper yard bags - OR -
- Bundles tied with fiber twine (4' x 2' x 2' limit) - OR -
- Rigid cans with handles and lids (32 gal., 60 lb. limit) marked "yard"

NO food scraps allowed in extra yard debris

NO yard debris in plastic bags or recycling carts



Kitchen Tips

Visit The Recology Store to pick up your **free** kitchen organics container.

- Use it to collect food scraps
- Empty the contents into your curbside organics cart
- To keep the kitchen container clean, line with approved compostable or paper bags or paper towels

Extra Garbage

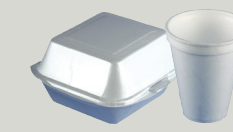
- There is an additional charge for garbage that does not fit in your garbage cart. **If your lid is open more than 6 inches, additional charges incur.**

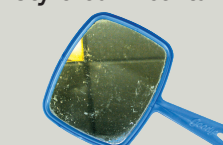
