Curbside Recycling:

Place next to recycle cart

- ▶ **Fluorescent tubes and CFL bulbs**
 - » Wrap tubes in newspaper to prevent breakage
 - » Place CFL bulbs in clean sealable bag
 - » Limit: Two tubes per collection
- ▶ **Small appliances**
 - » 2' x 2' x 2' or smaller
 - » Less than 35 lbs
- ▶ **Used motor oil**
 - » Put in clear plastic jug with screw top lid
 - » Label jugs with name and address
 - » Limit 2 gallons per collection

The store serves as an in-person

customer service center and drop off location for many hard-to-recycle items. Customers can pay their bill, chat with our staff of recycling experts, and purchase products that encourage a waste zero lifestyle! **If we pick up at your house, you can drop off at our store!** Recology CleanScapes residential customers may drop off limited quantities of the hard-to-recycle items listed below at the Recology Store in Shoreline.

Item	Preparation Instructions & Limitations
Fluorescent Tubes & Bulbs	▶ Unbroken bulbs only ▶ Limit 10 bulbs or tubes ▶ Tubes must be 4 ft long or less
Household Batteries	▶ Individually bag or tape ends of button, lithium and nickel batteries with non-conductive tape ▶ Tape the ends of all batteries ▶ Limit 1 gallon per drop-off
Car Seats	▶ Expired car seats only (6 years or older) ▶ Remove all fabric components: cover, straps and soft "comfort" foam ▶ Limit 2 car seats per drop-off
Used Bicycles & Bike Parts	▶ All types of clean bikes, bike parts and inner tubes accepted ▶ Limit 3 bikes per drop-off (donated for reuse)
Textiles	▶ All clothes, shoes and linens accepted ▶ Items must be clean, dry and free from mildew and hazardous material ▶ Textiles must be bagged ▶ Limit 32 gallons per drop-off
Styrofoam™	▶ Accepted items include packaging peanuts (bagged), rigid Styrofoam™ blocks, and Styrofoam™ take out food containers (clean and dry) ▶ #4 & #6 Styrofoam™ only (visit website for details) ▶ Remove any tape or labels ▶ Not to exceed 96 gallons
Computers & Computer Accessories	▶ 2' x 2' x 2' or smaller and less than 60 lbs ▶ Limit 3 items per drop-off ▶ Functional AND non-functional computers accepted
Small Appliances & Electronics	▶ Broken or unusable appliances only ▶ 2' x 2' x 2' or smaller and less than 60 lbs ▶ Limit 3 items per drop-off
Hard Cover Books	▶ Soft-cover books can be placed in curbside carts ▶ Not to exceed 32 gallons

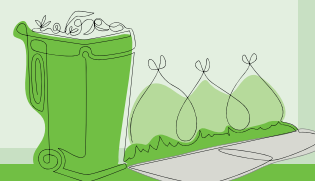
Extra Yard Debris

Put extra yard debris in:

- Heavy paper yard bags - OR -
- Bundles tied with fiber twine (4' x 2' x 2' limit) - OR -
- Rigid cans with handles and lids (32 gal., 60 lb. limit) marked "yard"

NO food scraps allowed in extra yard debris

NO yard debris in plastic bags or recycling carts



Kitchen Tips

Collect food scraps and food-soiled paper in a washable, lidded container.

To keep your container clean:

- Line with used paper towels, newspaper, shredded paper, or compostable bags.
- Sprinkle food scraps with baking soda to limit odors, if necessary.
- Freeze or refrigerate food scraps in container or compostable bag in the summer.

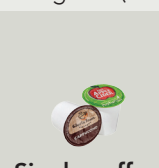
No hazardous waste or prohibited items

Extra Garbage

- There is an additional charge for garbage that does not fit in your garbage cart. If your lid is open more than 6 inches, additional charges incur.
- Place extra garbage in 32-gallon (or smaller) cans or bags. See reverse for extra garbage charges.



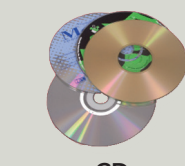

Hazardous Material Disposal

- ▶ Lawn chemicals and pesticides
- ▶ Flammable gas containers
