- ▶ **King County Hazardous Waste Surcharge** fee is collected by King County and used to fund the Hazardous Wastemobile and Factoria Household Hazardous Waste Drop-Off Service.
- Washington State Refuse Tax funds are used to provide financial assistance to local governments for repair and maintenance of public works projects.
