Fluorescent Tubes & Bulbs 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ Unbroken bulbs only ▶ Limit: 4ft long or less
Household Batteries 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ Separate button, alkaline/nickel, and lithium batteries into individual sealed bags. ▶ Separate rechargeable and non-rechargeable batteries ▶ Tape ends of ALL batteries with clear packing tape before bagging. ▶ No broken or leaking batteries
Used Bicycles & Bike Parts 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ All types of bikes, bike parts, and inner tubes accepted
Clothing/Linens 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ Clean & dry
Styrofoam™ 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ Clean & dry; remove all tape or labels ▶ Accepted items include packing peanuts (bagged) and rigid Styrofoam™ blocks and #4 Polyethylene "Flex Foam"
Small Appliances & Electronics 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ Non-Freon appliances only ▶ Electronics include TVs, computers, printers, cell phones
Furniture & household goods 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ Includes books, dishware, toys ▶ Items in good condition only!
