Please place carts at curb by 7am

**HOLIDAY COLLECTION:**  
If your collection day falls on or after Thanksgiving, Christmas, or New Year's Day your collection will be one day later that week.



### COLLECTION ISSUES:

Contact customer service within 24 hours to report missed collections. Visit [recology.com/bothell](http://recology.com/bothell) for collection updates and weather delays.

### CART PLACEMENT:

Where possible, place carts:

- ▶ Two feet apart with lids opening toward the street
- ▶ Without blocking cars, mailboxes, sidewalks, or driveways
- ▶ Within five feet of the street

Remove carts from street as soon as possible after collection.

## FREE! Special Item Recycling

Picked up at the curb — place on top of or next to recycle cart.

### Fluorescent Tubes & Bulbs

- ▶ Fluorescent lights are a household hazardous waste
- ▶ Wrap tubes in newspaper; secure with tape
- ▶ Place bulbs in a sealed clear plastic bag
- ▶ Limit 2 tubes/bulbs per collection
- ▶ Max 4' long



### Household Batteries

- ▶ Separate and bag batteries by type
- ▶ Tape ends of ALL batteries
- ▶ Visit [recology.com/bothell](http://recology.com/bothell) for battery preparation instructions



### Motor Oil

- ▶ Put in clear, screw-top plastic jugs
- ▶ Label jugs with name and address
- ▶ Limit: 3 gallons per collection



### Textiles

- ▶ Place clean, dry clothing and household textiles in a clear plastic bag



### Cooking Oil and Kitchen Grease

- ▶ Put in clear, screw-top plastic jugs
- ▶ Label jugs with name and address
- ▶ Limit: 3 gallons per collection



### Small Appliances & Electronics

- ▶ 2' x 2' x 2' or smaller and less than 60 lbs
- ▶ Place electronics in a clear plastic bag
- ▶ Limit: 4 items per collection



### ACCEPTED ITEMS

- ▶ VCRs, TVs, DVD players
- ▶ Cell phones, MP3 players
- ▶ Computers, keyboards, printers
- ▶ Stereos, microwaves

### Small Propane Canisters

- ▶ Place in a box
- ▶ Empty canisters only
- ▶ NO propane tanks



### Scrap Metal

- ▶ Examples: pipes, fencing, aluminum chair frames, bike parts
- ▶ 6' or smaller and less than 65 lbs



### Styrofoam™ Blocks\*

- ▶ Remove tape or labels
- ▶ Place Styrofoam™ in a clear plastic bag
- ▶ No packing peanuts



\*Styrofoam™ requires a special scheduled collection. Please submit a Service Request Form at [recology.com/bothell](http://recology.com/bothell), or contact customer service to request collection.

No food, liquid, Styrofoam<sup>™</sup> or loose plastic bags

## Empty and Clean Recyclables Only

- Place items **loose** in the **recycling** cart, not in bags or cartons.
- Place additional recyclables in clearly labeled sturdy bins or boxes next to the recycling cart.

Phone books    Mail, magazines, mixed paper    Plastic cups & food containers    Empty paper bags

## Plastic



Plastic bottles  
*(NEW! All colors — please place caps back ON plastic bottles)*

Plastic pots, buckets & baskets



Pill bottles  
*(no prescription vials)*    PVC pipe  
*(no longer than length of cart)*



Bagged plastic bags  
*(clean film wrap, newspaper, dry cleaner, & grocery bags)*

Bottles & jars

## Metal



Aluminum & metal cans



Foil & foil trays

Scrap metal  
*(less than 35lbs and 2' x 2' x 2')*

No plastic, glass or metal

## Food Scraps



Fruits & vegetables  
*(remove all produce stickers)*    Meat, fish & dairy    Shells & bones



Pasta & rice    Bread & grains    Eggshells & nutshells    Tea bags    Coffee grounds & filters

## Food-Soiled Paper



Paper bags, towels & napkins    Greasy pizza boxes    Uncoated paper plates & cartons



Approved compostable bags & packaging    Shredded paper  
*(loose or in paper bag)*    Wooden popsicle sticks & chopsticks

## Yard Debris



Grass & weeds    Leaves & twigs    Houseplants & flowers    Branches  
*(under 4' long, 4" thick)*

## Extra Yard Debris

Put extra yard debris in:

- Heavy paper yard bags - **OR** -
- Bundles tied with fiber twine  
*(4' x 2' x 2' limit)*

**NO overweight containers**  
**NO food scraps allowed in extra yard debris**



## Kitchen Tips

Visit The Recology Store to pick up your **free** kitchen organics container.

- Use it to collect food scraps, and empty the contents into your curbside organics cart.
- To keep the kitchen container clean, line with approved compostable or paper bags or paper towels.

**NO plastic bags**



# Garbage

No hazardous waste or prohibited items

## Extra Garbage

- There is an additional charge for garbage that does not fit in your garbage cart. *If your lid is open more than 6 inches, additional charges incur.*
- Put additional garbage in 32-gallon (or smaller) cans or bags.
