FREE twice per calendar year

Keep and eye out for your twice annual cleanup notice in the Spring and Fall.





On-Call Collection FREE twice per calendar year

For large items that don't fit in your carts. Limited to normal household debris. For more information and to schedule call 408.970.5100

Bulky Items

For an additional fee we can collect large items such as appliances and furniture. For rates, information or to schedule please call 408.970.5100 If you are a tenant in a multi-family building, please contact your property manager to schedule a pickup.





If you have extra garbage that won't fit in your containers, you may call Customer Service to purchase Extra Bag Tags. They can be used at any time and have no expiration date.



Place Used Oil in a jug & Used Oil Filter in a sealed clear plastic bag, and place on the ground next to your recycling cart on collection day.

BATTERIES

Curbside Battery Collection

Put household batteries (e.g. rechargeable, alkaline, button) inside a tightly sealed plastic bag, and place on the ground next to your recycling cart on collection day.



For safety, please tape over the contact points of each lithium battery. Look for "Lithium" or "Li" (most button and rechargeable batteries).

COMPOST

Steps to make food scrap collection easy!



You can place food waste, food scraps and soiled paper in your Organics Cart along with your yard waste.



Keep a small pail or compost bucket in the kitchen for easy access to dispose of food scraps and organics. These pails are sold in many stores and online. They are designed to be odor-free.



Use a paper bag or newspaper to line your kitchen pail for easy upkeep. Place all contents including paper bag or newspaper into Organics Cart on collection day.



For easy maintenance throughout the week, store food scraps or food waste in the freezer or the fridge and dispose of it in your Organics Cart on collection day.

From your kitchen to your Organics Cart



Wrap your food scraps in newspaper or a cardboard milk carton before placing into your organics cart.

Place paper towels or newspaper at the bottom of your own kitchen pail to soak up any liquids from your food.





You may line your own kitchen pail with paper bags or paper towels to keep it clean and make it easier to transfer to your organics cart.

Try refrigerating or freezing your food scraps and empty it into your organics cart the night before your service day.





DEBRIS BOXES

Recology South Bay provides debris box, compactor and commercial recycling services throughout Santa Clara County.

Debris boxes are best used for medium to large projects, including business construction and demolition, and residential clean-ups. Example materials collected include: concrete, wood, bricks, metals, asphalt, sheetrock, glass, porcelain, concrete, and dirt; a variety of plastics such as PVC pipe, packaging, and yard or landscaping materials. Call 408.970.5100 for rates and to schedule service.
