COMPOSTING: Are you in compliance?



Assembly Bill 1826 (AB 1826) is a law enacted by the State of California that requires businesses and Multi-Family Dwellings to begin organics collection services.

Phase one of AB 1826 focused on organic waste in the garbage. Multi-family dwellings that generate 4, 8, or more cubic yards per week of organic waste are required to have collection services for their landscape and yard waste materials.

PHASE TWO IMPLEMENTATION

The second phase of AB 1826 focuses on garbage service. Generators of the following garbage volumes will need to have organics collection service (yard waste and landscaping materials) by the corresponding dates.

JANUARY 1, 2019

4 Cubic Yards (or more)
of Garbage per week

JANUARY 1, 2020

2 Cubic Yards (or more)
of Garbage per week
