RECYCLE GUIDELINES

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

All items must be free of food and other contaminants, loose in the container.

PAPER

Mixed waste paper

Magazines & catalogs

Newspaper (including glossy ads)

Telephone books

Junk mail (envelopes with plastic windows are accepted)

Cardboard

Cereal & other dry food boxes (remove waxed liner)

Paper bags

Shredded paper (in clear bag only)

Giftwrap (no glossy foil gift wrap)

METALS (Please do not flatten)

Aluminum cans

Soda cans

Tin cans

Aluminum foil (must be clean and crushed)

PLASTICS

#2 Plastic milk cartons

#1 Clear plastic drink bottles (such as water & soda)

#3 through #7 plastics

Prescription pill containers. Labels removed

GLASS (Remove lids. They are recyclable)

Bottles (Soda, beer, wine, etc.)
Jars (Pickles, baby food, etc.)



UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS

PAPER

NO Tissue paper, toilet paper, paper towels and napkins

NO Waxed or plastic-coated paper & cardboard

NO Paper coffee cups or lids, paper cups or plates

NO Ice-cream cartons or frozen juice containers

NO Pizza boxes & other soiled papers and cardboard

NO Pet food bags

NO Waxy milk cartons or juice boxes

NO Glossy foil gift wrap

NO Hardcover books

METALS

NO Scrap metals or engine parts

NO Foil juice pouches or foil-looking food bags

PLASTICS

NO Plastic bags of any kind

NO Take-out containers of any kind

NO Clamshell containers

NO Microwave cookware

NO Meat, bakery, or vegetable trays and lids

NO Cups, plates or utensils

NO Aseptic packaging (soy/nut milk containers, juice boxes)

NO Water hoses

NO Shrink wrap

STYROFOAM

NO Styrofoam cups or fast food containers

NO Packing peanuts

HOUSEHOLD ITEMS

NO Ceramic plates and cups, dishes or china

NO Plate, window or mirror glass

NO Lightbulbs

NO Wire or clothes hangers

NO Batteries

NO Garbage, food waste, green waste, brush, grass or wood

NO Rope of any kind

NO Clothes

NO Stuffed animals

NO CONTAINERS THAT HAVE HELD TOXIC

MATERIALS (Any container with a WARNING or CAU-

TION label)

Automotive product containers (gas, oil, antifreeze, etc.)

Garden products (i.e., fertilizers or pesticides)

Aerosol cans, cleaning product containers

Paint or stain containers
