

Recycling is everyone's **RESPONSIBILITY**

China's Recycling Import Rules have changed

– Recycle items MUST be empty, clean and dry —

Combine glass food & beverage jars, plastic bottles and tubs, papers and all metal food and beverage containers in your blue recycling cart or bin.

Cardboard must be flattened to fit inside of the container with the lid closed. Customers with cart service that have extra cardboard that cannot fit inside a cart must be flattened and neatly stacked into 4'x 4' sections and placed alongside the recycling

cart.

PAPER

Bags (paper, all colors) Cardboard Egg cartons (non-styrofoam) Envelopes, mail & magazines Newspapers Phonebooks & soft cover books Wrapping paper (non-metallic)

> **GLASS** Glass bottles Glass jars

ALL RECYCLES NEED TO BE EMPTY, CLEAN AND DRY!

> Shredded paper should be in a clear plastic bag or a securely closed paper bag and placed in the recyle cart.

Please, NO:

- Food contaminated packaging
- Garden hoses or rubber gloves
- Packing peanuts or styrofoam
- Light bulbs or window glass

PLEASE REMOVE ALL PACKING MATERIALS before placing cardboard boxes in your recycling container.

METAL

Aluminum cans Aluminum foil and trays (clean) Paint cans (must be empty or dry) Spray cans (must be empty) Steel (tin) cans

PLASTIC Bottles and Tubs All plastics with or without the recycling symbols (except #6 Styrofoam/Polystyrene, see back for reuse options)



Recycle grocery, produce, dry cleaning and bread bags by bundling together inside a clear plastic bag.

ENVIRONMENTAL DAY EVENTS

Annually in the Spring and Fall, Recology hosts Environmental Days for Santa Clara residents. These events are designed to promote recycling, reuse and diversion of usable materials from the landfill.

MATERIALS ACCEPTED:

- Residential documents for confidential shredding (2 box limit)
- Electronic Waste (computers, monitors, printers, etc.)
- Universal Waste (batteries, cell phones, CFLs and fluorescent tubes)
- Clothing must be in good condition, no stained, torn or broken items as the purpose is to donate for reuse.

Residents must provide a current utility bill and personal identification (i.e., Driver's License) to verify eligibility for this free drop-off program.

OIL, FLUORESCENTS and BATTERIES

(Only for Single Family Homes)

USED MOTOR OIL: Used motor oil should be placed in a plastic container no larger than one gallon with a screw top lid. You may place up to three one-gallon containers next to your recycling cart for pick up on your regular collection day.

USED OIL FILTERS: Put used oil filters (fully drained) in sealed, leak-proof plastic bags and place next to your recycling cart.

COMPACT FLUORESCENT LIGHT BULBS: Put in clear ziploc-type plastic bags and place next to recycling cart.

BATTERIES: Call Mission Trail Waste Systems regarding battery collection (408) 727-5365.
