LEVEE PROJECT UPDATE Your Measure P Investment at Work



PROGRESS UPDATE

- The Levee Improvements Project resumed work in the Phase 1 area (Port Royal Drive to Shorebird Park), starting with the closure of the Baffin Street crossing to Belmont/Redwood Shores.
- Sheet pile installation and grading in the Phase 3 area (San Mateo Bridge to Anchor Road) has finished, marking the completion of essentially all permanent sheet pile installation for the entire project. With this work done, sheet pile installation and grading on all city-owned and permitted areas are finished which means the City is one step closer to project completion and an upgraded levee wall structure.
- In July, the Levee Improvements Project conducted additional paving work along Beach Park Boulevard to expand and maximize safety efforts in the area.
- The City of Foster City partnered with Bowditch Middle School and the San Mateo-Foster City School District to collaborate on a detour route and alternative meeting locations for Bowditch students to enhance safety and help alleviate traffic around the project area along Beach Park Boulevard.
- The anticipated schedule of Levee Trail closures is as follows. All schedules are subject to change due to weather, unforeseen circumstances or other factors:
 - Phase 1: Southern project limit to Shorebird Park Oct. 2020 Jan. 2023
 - ▶ Phase 2: Shorebird Park to San Mateo Bridge Jan. 2021 Nov. 2022
 - ▶ Phase 3: San Mateo Bridge to northern project limit Apr. 2021 Dec. 2022
- Please note that even when work is not underway in a specific location, it is not safe for the public to be anywhere inside the work zone. Trespassing into the closed, fenced trail and staging areas is prohibited at all times.
