

## Items NOT ACCEPTED in 3YD / 4YD / 6YD Temporary COD Bins

## Applies to All COD Bins

## \*\* NO HEAVY ITEMS

NO Construction Materials

NO Remodeling Materials

NO Carpet or Padding

**NO Mattresses** 

NO Furniture

NO Large Appliances

NO Computers or Monitors

**NO Televisions** 

NO Fluorescent Tubes

**NO Microwaves** 

NO Concrete

NO Rocks or Gravel

NO Stumps/Trunks or Branches larger than 2" in diameter

## \*\*NO DIRT OR SOD OF ANY KIND\*\* (THIS IS VERY IMPORTANT)

NO Large Metal Items

**NO Car Parts** 

**NO Tires** 

NO Toxic Waste or Chemicals (including Industrial Waste)

NO Treated Wood – (Pressure Treated – green fence posts- Creosote, etc)

Note: Wood is ok in Bins - Painted wood is ok

Upon **REMOVAL** of Bins - lids must be **Completely Closed**- Bin must be in same place as it was for delivery

The bin should not be heavier than 500 pounds. Rule of thumb: if the bin CANNOT be moved by 1 person, likely it weighs more than 500 pounds.
