

CHRISTMAS TREE RECYCLING 2022-2023

Tree preparation for both curbside collection and drop-off:

- Remove all tree stands (metal, plastic, wood), ornaments, lights, tinsel, etc.
- Flocked trees cannot be composted and must go to landfill, fees apply.
- Apartment building tenants should contact their manager and request that they set up one day for holiday tree collection at the property.

CURBSIDE COLLECTION

Bay Cities Refuse

Sausalito, Marin City

 Set tree on curb or cut up to fit in the green cart for your regular pickup day. Trees over 7ft must be cut in half. No date restrictions.

Marin Sanitary Service

Larkspur, Greenbrae, Kentfield, Las Gallinas Valley, Ross, San Anselmo, San Rafael, Fairfax and Ross Valley (Sleepy Hollow and Oak Manor)

- Mon, Jan 2 Fri, Jan 13, 2023
 Put tree on curb for your regular yard waste pick-up day. Trees over 6ft must be cut in half.
- After Fri, Jan 13, 2023
 Trees collected curbside will result in a charge on your bill of \$5 per tree.
- Trees can be cut up and placed in the green cart for any regular collection day. Lid must close.

Mill Valley Refuse

Almonte, Alto, Belvedere, Corte Madera, Mill Valley, Homestead, Strawberry and Tiburon

Starting the week of Jan 2, 2023
 Put tree on curb for your regular green waste pick-up day.
 Trees over 5ft must be cut in half.

Recology Sonoma Marin Customers in Novato

- Mon, Jan 2 Fri, Jan 6, 2023
 Place at the curb for collection for your regular collection day.
 Trees over 6ft must be cut in half.
- Trees can be cut up and placed in the yard waste cart for any regular collection day. Lid must close.

Recology Sonoma Marin Customers (except Novato)

Bolinas, Forest Knolls, Inverness, Marshall, Muir Beach, Nicasio, Olema, Point Reyes Station, San Geronimo, Stinson Beach, West Marin and Woodacre

• Cut up tree and place in the yard waste cart for any regular collection day. Lid must close.

Tamalpais CSD

- Tue, Jan 10 Fri, Jan 13, 2023 Put tree on curb for your regular collection day.
- \$30 charge for collection before Jan 10th or after Jan 13th.
- Trees can be cut into pieces up to 2 ft long and 4 inches in diameter and placed in the green cart. Lid must close.

NOTE: Trees taller than 6 ft must be cut in half.

Point Reyes: Mon, Dec 26, 2022 – Fri, Jan 13, 2023, 8:00am-5:00pm.

Ross: Mon, Jan 2 – Fri, Jan 13, 2023

 Marin Art & Garden Center, 30 Sir Francis Drake Blvd. (across from fire station)
 Please DO NOT drop trees at the Fire Station.

Until Jan 31, 2023:

 Marin Resource Recovery Center, 565 Jacoby St., San Rafael. Residents may drop off up to 2 trees. There will be a charge for flocked trees.
