SENATE BILL 1383 COMING SOON

American Canyon residents will soon be able to put more food scraps and food-soiled paper into their green yard waste carts. A new California law, SB 1383, went into effect on January 1, 2022. This law requires that all residents and businesses must subscribe to a three-cart program: recycling, organics, and garbage.

Recology is working with local agencies to finalize the details of implementing this new law in the City of American Canyon. Customers will be notified once the organic items can be included in the green cart. Those that do not have three-cart services will be contacted to set up organics service.



BULKY ITEM COLLECTIONS

Take advantage of our Bulky Item Collections program!

Residential customers may schedule one collection each year at no additional charge. During the month of September, residential customers also get a free Bulky pick up paid the city of American Canyon.

Residents are entitled to up to two cubic yards (3ft x 3ft x 6ft) or 12, 32-gallon garbage bags, weighing no more than 60 pounds. Items must be placed out by 5 AM on collection day.
