USING COMPOST

Compost is often used to improve garden soils, or mixed with topsoil to establish a proper base for a new lawn. It can also be mixed with other products to create an excellent potting soil. For best results, compost should be mixed in with native soils. Some plants are very sensitive, and may react adversely to being planted in pure compost. When in doubt, consult our staff.

As you may know, the price of bark is tied to the price of wood products that are sold as fuel for industrial boilers. As a result, bark prices have risen steadily over the years.

As the demand for waste wood increases, it can cause severe shortages in the material available to be ground into landscape bark.
