

PARTNER SPOTLIGHT: FREE FOOD-SCRAP PAILS

Did you know Californians are no longer allowed to put food scraps in the garbage? Instead, all food scraps and food-soiled paper must go in your green organics cart.

For easier handling and storage of food scraps in the kitchen, you can get a free pail, designed specifically for this purpose.

Collect yours by stopping by the San Benito County Integrated Waste Management booth at the County's Earth Day Celebration in downtown Hollister on April 22 between 11 AM and 2 PM.

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE (HHW)

Anything labeled hazardous, dangerous, flammable, etc. requires special handling and should not go into any of your curbside carts.

Take items such as motor oil, paint, batteries, and leftover household cleaning products to an

HHW event at John Smith Road Landfill (2650 John Smith Road). Events are held on the third Saturday of every month. More info is available at cosb.us/HHW.

BULKY & RECYCLABLE ITEMS

County Events

San Benito County hosts free quarterly Bulky Item Drop-off events throughout the year for local residents.

This year these weekend-long events, held at John Smith Road Landfill (2650 John Smith Road), will be March 25–26, June 24–25, Sept. 23–24, and Dec. 9–10.

Recology Curbside Collections

Residential customers get two Bulky Item Curbside Collections each year at no additional charge.

It's a convenient way to get rid of large broken or worn-out household items that don't fit in curbside bins. Residents can put out up to 2 cubic yards of materials, up to 5 pieces of electronic waste, and up to 2 appliances or furniture items.

CONTAMINATION REDUCTION: BATTERIES

Old batteries can be very dangerous. They can leak heavy metals and even catch on fire!

Never put batteries in your recycling or garbage carts.

Instead, place household batteries in a sealed, clear plastic bag and put it on top of your blue recycling cart. Be sure to tape the ends of lithium batteries with clear plastic tape. Your recycling driver will collect the bagged batteries safely.

Another option is to bring batteries to one of the County's monthly Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) events, held every third Saturday, at the John Smith Road Landfill, 2650 John Smith Road. Find details at cosb.us/HHW.
