Davis Street in Vacaville. The Vacaville Facility is open Tuesday through Saturday from 9AM until 3PM.

The Vacaville Facility also hosts a **HHW Disposal Center** that is open *on Saturdays only* from 9AM until 3PM. Here you may drop off auto batteries, antifreeze, paint, solvents, thinners, pesticides, herbicides, aerosols, gas, auto fluids, fluorescent lighting tubes, spa and pool chemicals, or other household hazardous waste. Materials are accepted from residential customers only. No appointments are necessary.

Mattress & Carpet Recycling

Residential customers may recycle up to 5 dry, unsoiled, used mattress & box springs per day and folded or rolled used carpet & pad that is dry and free of nails, dirt, and soil at the **Recology Vacaville Solano Recycling Facility** *on Saturdays only* from 9AM until 2PM. Residents must lift and deposit all items on their own.

What can and cannot be recycled?

Following is a list of acceptable and *unacceptable* materials for the blue recyclables Toter[®]. For information about recycling and other services, click *recology.com* or call us at 707-678-4026.

Paper

Newspaper, boxes, bags, cardboard (flattened), clean pizza boxes, magazines, catalogs, glossy paper, phone books, softcover books, shredded paper in paper bags, junk mail, envelopes, all colors of office paper.

No hardcover books or binders; soiled papers; food wrappings; napkins, tissues or towels; waxed paper milk cartons or waxed paper juice cartons.

Glass

All beverage and food containers in all colors. Empty container, rinse, and remove lid or cap.

No drinking glasses; ceramics; window glass or mirrors; light bulbs or fluorescent tubes.

Metal

Food and beverage cans (aluminum, steel, and tin). Rinse. Clean aluminum pans or foil. Empty aerosol cans. Metal lids from jars.

No electronic or computer equipment; hangers; scrap metal; fuel or propane tanks, etc.

Plastic

All #1 through #7 narrow-neck bottles (water, soda, and detergent bottles), trays & containers. All California Redemption Value (CRV) containers. Plastic tubs for margarine, butter, yogurt, etc. Empty all containers and rinse.

No plastic toys, cups; garden hoses, etc.; plastic bags; Styrofoam; clam-shell food containers; PVC or other piping.

- Toters® should be placed out with the wheels touching the curb. The lid should open to the street with the handle in the back.
- Don't block the sidewalk.

- Remove Toters® from curb as soon as possible after pickup and place them out of view from the street.

Dixon Residential Collection and Recycling Services

Welcome! Recology Dixon is proud to provide you with disposal and recycling services. This flier provides information needed to use these services. If you have any questions or special needs, just give our office a call at 707-678-4026, Monday-Friday between 8AM and 5PM. Click our website at recology.com to contact us, get information about services, enroll in E-BillPay service, or take advantage of our Pay-By-Phone service. Customers are now able to pay their bills over the phone, as well as online, by mail, and in-person. Pay-By-Phone is free for customers to use at any time. Call 707-635-9041 to make your payment. Please have your account number available. We accept American Express, Discover, MasterCard, and Visa credit cards, or we can debit your bank account. Remember, we're here to help!

We provide automated residual waste, yardwaste, and recyclables collection. Collection for all materials happens on the same day but not necessarily the same time.

Containers and Services

Toters[®] are used for residual waste, yardwaste, and recyclables. Each Toter[®] is a 96-gallon container that holds up to 200 pounds and is equal to 3 standard garbage cans. Toters[®] are provided by **Recology Dixon**.

Our trucks cannot lift over 200 pounds. Please be careful not to exceed weight limits. Fees may be charged for damage to overweight Toters[®].

Gray for Garbage

The gray Toter[®] is used for residual waste that cannot be recycled. **Personal cans or bags outside the Toter**[®] **will not be collected.** Extra gray Toters[®] are available for an additional charge.

Plastic bags may be used in gray Toters[®]. Loose ash, sawdust, animal waste, and packing peanuts must be secured in bags and

then placed into your gray Toter®.

Items such as dirt, rocks, cement, wood, furniture, and large items that require special handling will not be picked up if they are placed in your Toter®. Call for disposal instructions and information on additional charges for this extra service.

It is illegal to dispose of hypodermic needles, syringes, or lancets in the trash. Place these items in an FDA-approved plastic container, and bring the container to the **HHW Disposal Center**, 855¹/₂ Davis Street in Vacaville, *on Saturdays only*, between 9AM and 3PM.

Green for Yardwaste

Your green Toter® is used for yardwaste. Leaves, grass clippings, weeds, vegetables, bread, fruit, and tree or shrub prunings should be placed in the green Toter®. Cut tree and shrub prunings small enough to fit inside. Lids must be closed. Extra tree and shrub prunings may be bundled (2' x 3') with twine (please, no wire), then placed next to the green Toter®. Do not place on top.

Extra green Toters® are available for an additional charge. Extra 32-gallon cans owned by customers may be used for yardwaste only. The yardwaste containers must be sturdy and must have handles and lids. Your green Toter® must be set out in order to put out extra cans of yardwaste. There is no extra charge for this service.

Yardwaste is not landfilled but instead is used in a number of recycling processes, including composting at local facilities.

Do not put the following in your green yardwaste Toter®:

Plastic or paper bags, hazardous waste, animal feces, lumber, palm tree fronds, oleanders, dirt or rocks.



Blue for Recyclables

The blue Toter® is used for recyclables. The recycling program is easy and convenient, but you should know what materials can be recycled. Placing only the proper materials out for collection helps keep the cost of this service low. Materials that can be recycled are determined by the recycling company that purchases the materials. Check the list on the back of this mailer for accepted and unaccepted items.

Special Pickup Service

We provide **Special Pickup Service** to collect materials that do not fit in your gray Toter[®]. Call us at least one work day in advance to schedule these services so we can guarantee pickup. An employee will give you an estimate of charges and answer any questions about this service.

Special Pickup Service is for occasional extra residual waste or large items.

Place all waste inside your containers. Bags left out for **Special Pickup Service** must be heavy-duty plastic, sealed, and cannot weigh more than 25 pounds.

Collection Day

Place Toters® out at your designated collection area by 6:00AM the day of your pickup. A specific pickup time cannot be guaranteed.

Please remove empty Toters® and store them out of view prior to 6:00PM on pickup day. If you do not receive a pickup, call the office immediately at 707-678-4026.

A special pickup may be scheduled at an additional charge for collection problems such as containers not out on time, overweight containers, improper material in containers, and other problems.

Free Compost

Dixon residents may bring their shovels and load up on free compost between April 1 and Oc-

tober 31 at the **Recology Hay Road Landfill**, weather permitting. Just show your **Recology** bill or other documents at the scalehouse or office to verify that you are a resident. Customers are entitled to 3 yards per visit—one visit per day while supplies last. Call the landfill at 707-678-4718 for information.

Recycling and Buy-Back Facility

The **Recology Dixon Recycling Facility** and **Buy-Back Center** will assist you with your common recycling needs. The Facility is located at 302 N. First Street. Call 678-4026 or click on *recology.com* for information.

The **Recycling and Buy-Back Center** is open from Tuesday through Saturday, 9:00AM until 3:00PM. This Center offers free disposal of common recyclable items including oil filters; cooking oil; scrap glass; tin food cans; corrugated cardboard; newspaper; mixed paper and shredded paper; plastic items such as milk jugs, and household batteries. The Center also pays various amounts for recyclable materials such as aluminum cans; glass (sorted by color); motor oil; and some plastics.

There is an **Electronic Waste Disposal Center** that is located within the Recycling
Buy-Back Center in Dixon. The **Electronic Waste Disposal Center** is open *on Saturdays only* from 9AM until 3PM. Drop off television
sets, computer monitors, fax machines,
laptops, radios, scanners, mouse/keyboards,
microwave ovens, cell phones, hair dryers,
clocks, VCRs, printers and computers. There
is a limit of 5 items per customer. Residents
must lift and deposit all items on their own.

Other Recycling Locations

Dixon customers may use the **Recology Recycling Facility** that is located at 855¹/₂
