

## LEVEE PROJECT UPDATE

## Your Measure P Investment at Work



As the project continues, the community is reminded that even when work is not underway in a specific location, it is not safe for the public to be anywhere inside the work zone. Trespassing into the closed, fenced trail and staging areas can incur additional cost to the City and project, and is prohibited at all times.

- On March 6, the City Council approved Contract Change Order No. Thirty-one (CCO #31) to Shimmick Construction Co. Inc and the contractor is working toward the following milestones:
  - Target Date for Phase 2 Milestone (Shorebird Park to San Mateo Bridge): End of May 2023
  - Target Date for Phase 3 Milestone (North of San Mateo Bridge): End of July 2023

All schedules are subject to change and the most current, up-to-date schedule is always available on the homepage of the project website: fostercitylevee.org

At the end of March, the City restored public access to Phase 1 of the Levee Bay Trail. The contractor is required to open the whole trail for public use by October 2023, with minor correctional items to be completed within the phases. January 2024 is the final Project completion date.
