CREATE LESS WASTE AT HOLIDAY PARTIES

During this season of parties, festivities, and fun the amount of recycling and composting generated in households and offices significantly increases. It starts with Thanksgiving, the biggest food week of the year.

Here are some strategies to reduce waste during the holiday season and any time you're entertaining:

 $\rightarrow\,$ Put containers for food scraps, recycling, and garbage next to each other so guests can easily compost and recycle.

 \rightarrow Consider renting or borrowing dishes, glassware, and cloth napkins to make the party more elegant and eliminate the waste from disposable items, especially single-use plastic.

 \rightarrow Put leftovers into containers and send them home with your guests. According to the hunger-relief organization Feeding America, 119 billion pounds of food is wasted. We all should do our part to reduce that waste.

RESPONSIBLE BATTERY DISPOSAL

Many holiday gifts, decorations, and everyday gadgets use batteries. When they run down, please recycle them.

Recology accepts regular household batteries (AAA-D, 9V, button cell, and rechargeable) for recycling. Please tape the ends of batteries to help prevent fires. Place household batteries in a clear, zippered bag and set them on top of your recycling cart on collection day.

Please do not put batteries in the garbage.

HOLIDAY TREE RECYCLING

Recology accepts holiday trees for recycling! Flocked trees (sprayed with artificial snow) are not accepted.

- 1. Remove all decorations, tinsel, and tree stands.
- 2. Cut tree into three-foot sections.
- 3. Place small branches/pieces inside the cart.
- 4. Make sure your organics cart is at the curb alongside your tree.





TIPS FOR A SUCCESSFUL

ORGANICS PROGRAM

Remember to put your green cart out for weekly collection. And:

→ Prep your cart by placing materials such as leaves, grass, newspaper, paper towels, or a paper bag at the bottom of the cart. This helps prevent food from sticking to the bottom.

 \rightarrow Make sure cart lids are entirely closed.

 → Keep a collection container near your food prep area to dispose of food scraps. Recology provides a free, dishwasher-safe pitcher for kitchen scraps. Call
Customer Service at 408.842.3358 to request yours.

 $\rightarrow\,$ Line the container with a paper towel, paper bag, or newspaper to help absorb liquids and keep the container clean.

 $\rightarrow~{\rm Every}~{\rm day}~{\rm or}$ two, empty the contents into your green cart.

→ Paper bags are acceptable. Plastic or bags labeled "compostable" or "biodegradable" bags are unacceptable.

 \rightarrow Store food scraps in your freezer and empty them into your green cart the night before service.
