Starting November 1, 2023, Recology will be your new recycling, food & yard waste, and garbage hauler. The City of Tukwila and Recology are committed to a smooth transition. Recology's local customer service and operations teams are ready to assist you and provide high quality service.

Please call your customer service center before November 1 at 206.994.3900 or visit Recology.com/Tukwila to set up your account and verify your information. Here's what you can expect during this transition:

• Equipment (carts/dumpsters/roll offs/compactors) and decals You will keep your existing equipment. Colors for each type of material will stay the same. Starting in September, Recology staff will re-decal your dumpsters, carts, or roll off containers.

Rates

Recycling will remain free as part of your garbage service. Food & yard waste service for food scrap collection will be available free for the first year when you sign up to be a new food & yard waste customer. Current garbage and food & yard waste rates will increase due to the rising costs of trucks, fuel, labor, and other factors. Rates would have increased with any new hauler contract, and will now be in line with other King County communities.

Proposals were then judged on a mixture of price and services offered. Through this process Recology was selected and the contract was approved by the City Council.
