RECOLOGY SOLUTIONS

Used mattresses are accepted free of charge for recycling at the Recology Vacaville Solano Recycling Facility on Saturdays from 9 AM to 3 PM, at 855 1/2 Davis Street, Vacaville. Mattresses must be clean, dry and free of insects.

Recology offers two convenient carpet drop off locations. Dixon residential customers may recycle their carpet at the Recology Vacaville Solano Recycling Facility on Saturday's from 9 AM to 3 PM. Carpeting may also be recycled at our Recology Hay Road facility located at 6426 Hay Road in Vacaville on Saturday's from 9 AM to 4 PM.

The Recology Dixon Recycling and Buy-Back Center, located at the corner of First and C streets, accepts large corrugated cardboard boxes like those bicycles and mattresses are packaged in. The Center is open Tuesday thru Saturday from 9 AM to 3 PM. Boxes may also be flattened and placed in your blue recyclable cart.

HOLIDAY TREE RECYCLING

Recology will collect your Christmas tree curbside until Friday, January 19th. Just cut your tree into three-foot-long sections and stack them next to the green organics cart.

Trees may always be cut to fit inside the green organics cart. Trees placed in the green organics cart must be free of flocking, ornaments, tinsel, and tree stands. The cart lid must be able to close. Trees with these materials may be cut up and placed in your gray garbage cart or you may call for a special pickup.



GIVING BACK

EXTRA TRASH SOLUTION

Call Recology at 707.678.4026 at least one day in advance, and we will collect extra or oversized trash that does not fit in your gray garbage cart. Use this service for holiday extra trash or for large items that do not fit in your gray cart. There are extra charges for this service. Call customer service for information and costs.

PUT LEAVES IN THEIR PLACE

Only water should go in the storm drain system. Please refrain from raking leaves into the street and properly contain leaves for recycling or debris for disposal.

Homeowners must make sure that commercial gardeners do not rake or blow leaves into the street.

NO OLEANDERS

Did you know oleander plants are toxic to humans, household pets, and other animals? The plants remain poisonous even when dead or when the cuttings are dried.

This is why oleander is not allowed in your green organics cart. The composting process does not remove all the toxic poisons in the plant and even small amounts of oleander will contaminate the compost.

Place all oleander trimmings in the gray garbage cart. Never place oleander in the green organics cart. Yard waste containers with oleander will be tagged and left unemptied.



RECYCLING REMINDERS!

WHAT CAN BE RECYCLED...

Customers in Dixon are able to recycle a great variety of materials. The following is a list of the materials that can and cannot go in your blue cart:

PAPER

Newspaper, boxes, paper bags, cardboard (flattened), magazines, catalogs, glossy paper, phone books, softcover books, shredded paper in paper bags, junk mail, envelopes, all colors of office paper.



GLASS

All beverage and food containers in all colors. Empty container, rinse, and remove lid or cap.



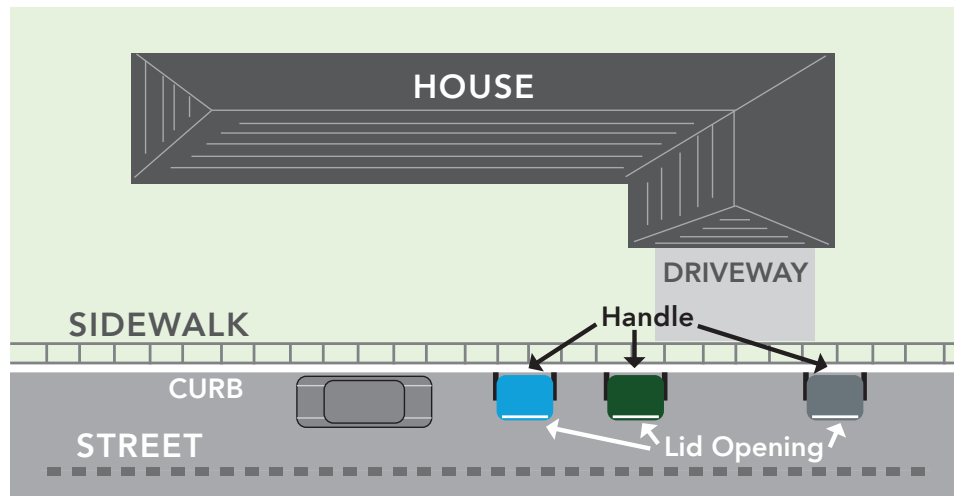
PLASTIC

All beverage and food containers in all colors. Empty container, rinse, and remove lid or cap.



METAL

Food and beverage cans (aluminum, steel, and tin). Rinse. Clean aluminum pans or foil. Empty aerosol cans. Metal lids from jars.



CHECK FOR PROPER CART PLACEMENT

- Carts should be placed in the street with the wheels touching the curb.
- The lid should open to the street with the handle in the back.
- Don't block the sidewalk.
- Don't park cars within (3) three feet of carts.
- Place carts (3) three feet apart.
- Put carts out by 6 AM on your pickup day.
- Remove carts from the curb as soon as possible after pickup and place them out of view from the street.
