GROWING GOOD, GREEN HABITS

ButtercuP is a family-owned diner that has been a part of the Vallejo community since 1992.

The Sonoma Boulevard restaurant, one in a chain of four in the Bay Area, serves breakfasts, lunches, and dinners made with fresh ingredients. When the state's food-scrap collection law went into effect last year, Vallejo manager Ben Shahvar saw it as an opportunity and called Recology to establish organics service.

"As with anything, change brings some challenges," he said. The

kitchen team had to get used to sorting compostable materials such as vegetable peelings and plate scrapings separately, for example. "We did what was necessary to be successful and do right by the environment."

Indeed, ButtercuP's commitment to putting compostable materials in the green bin has allowed the restaurant to reduce the size of its garbage bin. That means less to landfill and more nutrient-rich compost to local farms.

HOLIDAY TREE

COMPOSTING

Recology accepts natural holiday trees in the green cart.

- 1. Remove all ornaments, lights, tinsel, hooks, nails, and tree stands.
- 2. Cut the natural tree into sections that will fit in the green cart with the lid closed.

Flocked trees (sprayed with artificial snow) are not accepted in the green cart. Cut flocked trees to fit in the gray landfill bin with the lid closed or take them to the dump.
