2024 Student Poster Contest Rules

THEMES

TK-2nd Grade: Draw something that answers one or more of the following questions: What is healthy soil made of? How does healthy soil help grow the food we eat?

3rd-5th Grade: Draw something that answers one or more of the following questions: How can you tell if soil is healthy and what can you do to keep it healthy? How does healthy soil affect the food we grow?

6th-12th Grade: Draw something that answers one or more of the following questions: How does healthy soil contribute to a healthy environment? What type of organisms are found in healthy soil?

RULES

1. Students must create original artwork, no existing clip art, computer-generated graphics/characters, or other graphics permitted.
2. Messaging: No more than six words per poster. Use **BRIGHT colors** and **BOLD text**. Crayons, markers colored pencils, and other art materials are allowed.
3. Artwork must be in landscape format. Only 1 entry per student.
4. The artwork and entry form must be turned in by email to PosterContest@Recology.com by March 15th, 2024 as a PDF file.
