Acceptable HHW items include acids/bases, aerosol cans, automotive supplies (car batteries, motor oil, antifreeze, break fluids), cleaning products, fertilizers, pesticides, flammable liquids, fluorescent lights (compact and tubes), paints, inks and photo chemicals. Radioactive, explosive, medical and commercial waste is prohibited.

# GET READY! ELECTRIC LEAF BLOWERS ARE REQUIRED STARTING JULY 1

On July 11, 2023 the City Council adopted a zero-emission landscape equipment (ZELE) requirement that prohibits using gas powered landscaping equipment due to its negative impacts on health, and noise and air pollution, starting with gas powered leaf blowers and weed whackers (string trimmers) on July 1, 2024. Electric alternatives are available to help you or your professional landscaper begin phasing out gas-powered equipment now.

#### POPULAR SHREDDING EVENT IS BACK

Did you file your taxes and need those confidential documents shredded? Do you have piles of office paperwork lying around from working at home? If you answered "Yes" to these questions, you're in luck!

Residents and businesses can prevent identity theft by shredding sensitive documents at the City's popular free shredding event. Confidential document destruction includes items such as checks, pre-approved credit applications, credit card statements, outdated tax returns, pre-printed envelopes, return address labels and business cards. Participants are limited to three boxes (10" x 12" x 15") per vehicle and materials will be shredded on-site. Documents with paper clips and staples are acceptable.

Do not bring any e-waste or household hazardous waste materials.

Please follow these guidelines for smoother drop-off service:

- Please label "Shred only" on any shredding materials and leave them in the trunk.
- It is recommended to remove all other personal items from the trunk to avoid any accidents.
- Residents will open their trucks prior to driving up to the vendors, remain in their vehicles with their face masks on, and the vendors will pick up the shredding materials from the trunks.

#### RACHIO SMART SPRINKLER CONTROLLER SALE

The controllers allow users to tailor their watering schedules, make automatic weather adjustments and manage watering from anywhere with their smartphone.

This sale is eligible to be combined with Menlo Park Municipal Water's (MPMW) rebate program, which results in huge savings for MPMW customers.
