SOFT AND STRETCHY PLASTICS ARE TRASH

Soft and stretchy plastic items are NOT accepted in Recology's recycling programs. Common soft and stretchy items that go into the garbage container include:

- Cleaning wipes
- Face masks
- Plastic gloves
- Plastic storage bags
- Plastic packaging
- Plastic shopping bags
- Film or stretch wrap
- Bubble wrap and envelopes
- Condiment packets
- Chip bags and candy wrappers

WATCH OUT FOR ILLEGAL ITEMS!

It is illegal to dispose of hazardous materials in compost, recycling, or garbage containers. Improperly disposing of hazardous and toxic waste can result in serious harm to the health of people, pets, wildlife, and our environment. Containers found to have these materials will NOT be collected until such materials are removed.

PROHIBITED ITEMS INCLUDE:

- Fluorescent tubes and CFL light bulbs
- Syringes and needles
- Batteries of any kind or size
- Chemical cleaners, paints, solvents & other toxic chemicals
- Appliances, computers, monitors, TVs, and electronics







These items can be disposed of at Recology's Household Hazardous Waste facility, located at 2720 South Fifth Ave., Oroville; open the first and third Friday of each month from 9 AM - 2 PM.

SPRING 2024 FREE CLEAN UP EVENT

Sunday April 21st, 10 a.m. to 2 p.m.

Where: Oroville, CA - Recology Transfer Facility 2720 South 5th Avenue

Who: Oroville Residents only, no business waste. Proof of address required.

Requirements: All items must be source separated, no mixed loads will be accepted. Residents are responsible for unloading materials. Maximum size load will be 4 Cubic Yards.

The following items will be accepted

- $\sqrt{}$ **Tires:** There is a limit of 9 tires per vehicle.
- $\sqrt{}$ **E-waste:** televisions, video equipment, computer monitors etc.
- √ Household Appliances/ Scrap metal; includes freon containing items.
- $\sqrt{}$ **Mattresses:** including box springs and futon mattresses- detached.
- $\sqrt{}$ **Carpet:** needs to be rolled up, pads okay.
- √ Household Furniture
- √ Mixed Recyclables
- $\sqrt{}$ Vegetative Waste: nothing over 3 inch diameter will be accepted.

The following items will **NOT** be accepted at this event

- Ø Hazardous waste (Batteries, paints, oils, chemicals, florescent lights etc.)
- Ø Garbage
- Ø Mixed loads
- Ø Concrete. dirt, rocks, brick, asphalt, or sand
- Ø Treated Wood
- Ø Asbestos of any kind
- Ø Large household items: i.e. trampolines, play structures etc.
