Organics Collection

A green cart for food scraps and yard trimmings.

Environmental Days

Six times per year, residents are invited to drop off electronic waste for safe recycling, securely shred paper on-site, and pick up free compost during this event in Hollister and San Juan Bautista.

Bulky Item Collection

Twice yearly, residents can arrange for curbside collection of bulky items and reusable materials at no additional cost.

Neighborhood Cleanup

Residents can request large bins for garbage, recyclables, and litter cleanup.

CURBSIDE SET-OUT

Please have your carts set out by 6am on your service day.

Lids are to remain closed at all times. Don't overfill.
