FOOD RECYCLING MADE EASY!

- Collect food in newspaper, paper bags, or approved compostable bags. List available at www.bpiworld.org.
- 2. Take food collected to your cart or bin daily.
- 3. Use newspaper, shredded paper, or soiled napkins in between layers to absorb liquids, control pests, and reduce odor.
- 4. Keep lids closed at all times to minimize pests.
