Our **Compost** container(s) can be found \_\_\_\_\_

**Compost** correctly:

- Plant trimmings
- All food scraps (meat, bones, dairy, etc.)
- Soiled/small paper waste (pizza boxes, paper towels, napkins, coffee filters, tea bags, shredded paper, etc.)



 <p>A pail, bowl, or paper bag can be used to move your compostable materials to the green outdoor compost bin. *</p>	 <p>Line your pail with paper bags or newspaper to keep it clean.</p>	 <p>Plastic, glass, metal, and "compostable" plastics are not accepted in the compost program.</p>
