HOW TO USE YOUR KITCHEN PAIL



Use your kitchen pail to collect food scraps and transport them to your organics bin.



1. Line with newspaper, a paper towel, or paper bag.

Paper absorbs moisture which helps control odors and keeps the pail clean.

2. Empty every day or two into your organics bin.

Use your pail to transport uncoated soiled paper and food scraps to your organics bin.

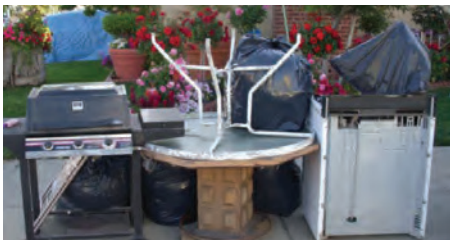

Twice Annual On-Call Clean-up Collection

VALID JULY 1ST, 2025, THROUGH JUNE 30TH, 2026

Please call 650.583.8536 and speak with one of our customer service specialists to schedule an On-Call Clean-up Collection. For more info, visit recology.com.

- All San Bruno single-family **AND** multi family units of less than 25 units are eligible for two on call clean up collections
- Customers must be current with their bill before scheduling pickup
- Scheduled cleanups occur on regular service days
- When you call to schedule your bulky items, be prepared to provide a list of items you would like to have picked up
- Large items such as sofas, mattresses and box springs, and bookshelves
- Limited to three cubic yards (3ft. x 3ft. x 9ft.) or twenty 32-gallon bags; however, you may request to use both collections at the same time for up to six cubic yards
- Weight limits may apply, and acceptability of items are at the discretion of the driver
- Unaccepted items will be left at the curb

Hard-to-Recycle Programs

Recology San Bruno offers free Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) drop-off for San Bruno residents.

Drop-off Location: Recology San Bruno Transfer Station
101 Tanforan Ave., San Bruno, CA 94066

Days/Hours: Tuesdays and Thursdays, 10:00 AM – 12:00 PM

Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) includes common household products that are labeled as flammable, toxic, corrosive, or reactive. These materials cannot go in your regular trash or recycling because they pose safety and environmental risks.

Items listed below are accepted at the transfer station:

- Electronics
(cell phones, computers, TVs, small appliances)
- Fluorescent tubes and bulbs
- Car and household batteries
- Motor oil* and oil filters
- Latex (water-based) paint*
- Antifreeze*

*5-Gallon Limit



Place household batteries in a sealed plastic bag and place it on top of your recycling cart on collection day.

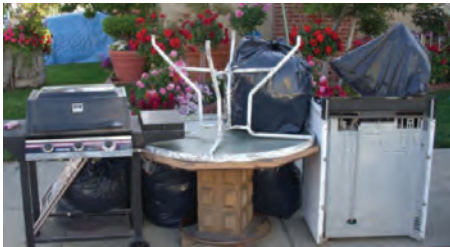

- Todas las unidades unifamiliares y multifamiliares de San Bruno de menos de 25 unidades son elegibles para dos colecciones de limpieza de guardia
- Los clientes deben estar al día con su factura antes de programar la recogida
- Las limpiezas programadas se realizan en días de servicio regulares
- Cuando llame para programar sus artículos voluminosos, prepárese para proporcionar una lista de artículos que desea que recojan
- Artículos grandes como sofás, colchones, somieres (la base) y estanterías (librero)
- Limitado a 3 yardas cúbicas (3 pies x 3 pies x 9 pies) o veinte bolsas de 32 galones; sin embargo, puede solicitar usar ambas colecciones al mismo tiempo por hasta seis yardas cúbicas
- Se pueden aplicar límites de peso y la aceptabilidad de los artículos queda a discreción del conductor
- Los artículos no aceptados se dejarán en la acera

Estos materiales no pueden depositarse en los contenedores habituales de basura o reciclaje, ya que presentan un riesgo para la seguridad y el medio ambiente.

Se aceptan los siguientes artículos en la estación de transferencia:

- Aparatos electrónicos (teléfonos celulares, computadoras, televisores, pequeños electrodomésticos)
 - Tubos fluorescentes y focos
 - Baterías de auto y domésticas
 - Aceite de motor* y filtros
 - Pintura de látex (a base de agua)*
 - Anticongelante*
