## Law (AB 341)

Mandatory Commercial Recycling (AB 341) requires all commercial generators that produce four or more cubic yards of solid waste per week to arrange for recycling collection. Learn more at [CalRecycle.ca.gov](http://CalRecycle.ca.gov).

- Prescription Medicine\*
- Food Scraps
- Liquids
