CITY FACILITIES HOLIDAY CLOSURE

City Hall will be closed from December 24 through January 4 in observance of the holiday season. COMMUNITY CENTER CONSTRUCTION PROJECT

Construction of the new Foster City Community Center continues to make steady progress. In October, crews focused on enclosing the building and beginning interior work. Roofing and waterproofing activities picked up across multiple roof levels to prepare the structure for winter weather, while exterior wall panels were added along the west and north sides of the building. Work also continued underground, with crews installing site utilities around the service yard and along Shell Boulevard.

The project has now entered a new phase, shifting from major structural construction to tasks that will seal and protect the building and support interior systems. The goal over the next few months is to achieve "dry-in," meaning the building will be fully enclosed and protected from the elements.

The project remains on track with no delays or extensions reported, and final completion is anticipated by July 2026.
