



## RECYCLING MISCONCEPTIONS

**STYROFOAM PRODUCTS are not recyclable in curbside programs.** Foam products can be bulky, lightweight, and easily contaminated with food, tape, and other residues that don't belong in recycling carts.

**PLASTIC BAGS AND FILM are not accepted in most curbside recycling programs.** This is because they can tangle sorting machinery and are made with materials that cannot be easily separated. Instead, take these items to designated drop-off points at grocery stores or reuse them whenever possible to reduce waste.

**SINGLE-USE PLASTICS,** also known as disposable plastics, **are not accepted in your recycling cart.** When possible, swap them for reusable options.

## Holiday composting tips

Each year, nearly 1 billion pounds of pumpkins and over 200 million pounds of turkey end up in landfills. Restaurants can lead the way in waste reduction by complying with state law SB 1383 and participating in the Recology Butte Colusa Counties organics program.

Create stations in the kitchen and common areas where staff and customers can dispose of food-prep and plate scrapings, including turkey bones, pumpkin pie crust trimmings, coffee grounds, corn cobs, and used paper towels and napkins. Even natural decorations, such as jack-o-lanterns and leafy centerpieces, can go in the green cart.

Let's turn seasonal discards into nutrient-rich compost and keep food out of the landfill. Together, we can serve up sustainability with every meal.

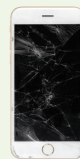
