IS YOUR BUSINESS IN A CAP DESIGNATED AREA?

Seattle Public Utilities Director's Rule SW-406 requires that all businesses in the Downtown Core and Capitol Hill's Pike/Pine Corridor have Clear Alleys Program (CAP) services. This requirement replaces dumpsters with a daily bag pickup service, creating cleaner, safer alleys. Contact Recology to purchase bags and receive guidance on managing your service.

Clean, empty, and dry: empty any food or liquid, clean the container with a quick rinse or scrape before tossing in your recycling container.

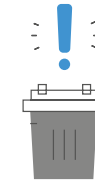


Please flatten your cardboard boxes.

Important: To Know for Your Business



SOLID WASTE SORTING REQUIREMENTS

Businesses in the City of Seattle are not allowed to dispose of food waste, compostable paper, or recyclable items in the garbage (SMC 21.36.082 & 21.36.083). Call Recology to right-size your services.



COMPOSTABLE FOOD PACKAGING REQUIREMENT

Dine-in service must use durables or compostable service ware. Take-out service packaging must be either compostable or recyclable (SMC 21.36.084 & 21.36.086). Learn more bit.ly/SPU-FoodSVC



LOCK YOUR WASTE CONTAINERS

By direction of Director's Rule SW-406, containers which are stored in public view must be locked and securely staged (SW-406). Locking also prevents illegal dumping, pests, and scatter. You can purchase a lock through Recology Customer Service.



REVIEW YOUR WASTE BILL

We encourage customers to review their monthly waste bill for expected charges and fees. To reduce waste-related costs, consider right-sizing your service or adding recycling or composting. Contact Recology Customer Service to learn more about service options and pricing.



RETURN TRIP COLLECTION

Waste containers and/or dumpsters must be placed on the premises in a location that is satisfactory to the customer, compliant with the Seattle Fire Code, and accessible for collection by Recology. If access to containers is blocked—including by vehicles, structures, or houseless encampments—Recology may be unable to collect materials and Return Trip fees may apply; in such cases, please contact Recology Customer Service for scheduling.
