HOW MUCH TO BUY

Our staff can help estimate how much product you need. Here's a basic guide of yardage needed **to cover 2" deep:**

150 sq. ft. = 1 yd³ 300 sq. ft. = 2 yds³
450 sq. ft. = 3 yds³ 1100 sq. ft. = 1 unit

- Step 1 - measure the length and width of each bed (in feet)
- Step 2 - multiply the length x width x depth (convert to feet)
- Step 3 - add the totals together, then divide by 27, this converts the total volume into cubic yards.

Garbage, compostable service ware, lumber, plywood, stumps, sod, dirt, rock, concrete, glass, plastic, metal, animal waste, hay, straw, animal bedding or construction and demolition debris in green pile.

NOTE: most of these items can be accepted next door at the McMinnville Transfer Station, Entrance located off of Alpha Rd.
