Climate Action & Adaptation Plan Update

In 2017, the City of Belmont adopted our first Climate Action Plan. The City is now updating the plan to incorporate new data, current best practices, and adaptation measures. The resulting Climate Action and Adaptation Plan will establish key strategies to increase resilience to climate change and reduce greenhouse gas emissions, while aligning with State emissions reduction targets.

The update will include:

- Analyzing and forecasting local greenhouse gas emissions
- Setting emissions reduction targets in alignment with State targets
- Engaging stakeholders in critical discussions about the mitigation measures necessary to meet these targets
- Integrating the parallel General Plan Safety Element Update, building on its recommendations regarding "adaptation" to the impacts of climate change, to help strengthen Belmont's climate resilience
